Please include a good *email* address on all club forms as we will continue to correspond by mass email to keep our costs down and to forward new information most expediently. Please note that we have added the option to join the club as a Junior Member. This membership requires the skater to be a current member of Brooklyn's Advanced Blades for the 2010-2011 season, at least Basic 5 figure skating level, must have a Basic Skills number and a copy of the Basic Skills card must be attached to your application. Junior members do not have voting rights and will be allowed to skate *only* on designated club sessions. A junior member must upgrade to full BFSC Home Club Member in order to take USFSA tests and/or compete on behalf of the Brooklyn Figure Skating Club. Our next season will run September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 – May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
